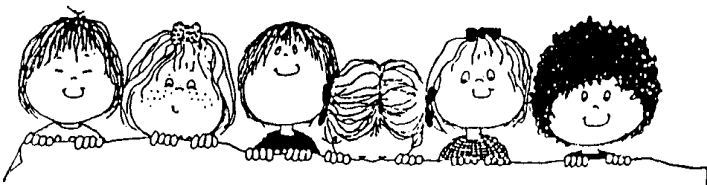
## Roger Bacon Band Performs in Reds' Opening Day Parade
